- Fill your car's gas tank

BE READY TO EVACUATE OR STAY AT HOME

Always listen to authorities regarding whether you should evacuate or stay at home. If driving conditions are dangerous, staying at home might be safer than leaving. But you should never ignore an order to evacuate.

KNOW THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A HURRICANE "WATCH" AND "WARNING"

Listen for National Weather Service alerts on TV or radio or check for them online.



A **HURRICANE WATCH** means hurricane conditions (sustained winds of 74 miles per hour [mph] or higher) are possible in a stated area.



A **HURRICANE WARNING** is more serious. It means hurricane-force winds are expected in a stated area.
